Connecting health to meet local needs

5th March 2014

Dear Mr Marshall,

I write to enquire as to whether the members of the Rotary Club of Umina Beach would be interested in learning more about the national eHealth record system and how they can register for their own eHealth record.

As the enclosed brochure details, the national eHealth record is a free Australian Government program that enables individuals to have access to their key medical information online. The information that can be stored in an eHealth record includes current medications, a summary of an individual's medical history, as well as a record of any allergies and immunisations.

If an individual gives permission this information can be accessed when needed by Health Professionals anywhere in Australia; for example, if someone visits a doctor who is not their usual GP the key information about their health can be made available to that doctor helping them to get better healthcare.

As the eHealth record is an opt-in system Central Coast NSW Medicare Local is contacting organisations across the Central Coast to provide more about the eHealth record and help people to register for their own record.

The eHealth team is able to support your members in a variety of ways. Some of the methods that have been well received by other organisations include; a presentation at a regular meeting, articles in a newsletter, a morning tea presentation and questions and answer session, having a stand at an existing event. The eHealth team are also fully trained in assisting people to register for their own eHealth record.

Internationally there are 1,200,000 Rotarians serving in 34,145 clubs through 530 districts in 210 countries.
