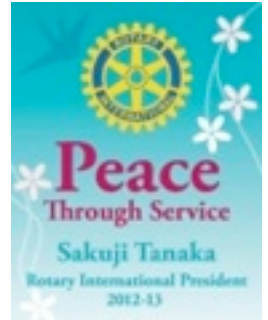

Page 6 Shows Steven boasting about adding a bit of colour to our Rotary meeting. But it was just black and white to me. Again he is seen introducing his visitors, Neville Threlfall, who was his mentor and is our guest speaker, and Neville's wife, Margaret, Plus Grace Hull, next to Margaret, and Jennifer Gagau on Margaret's left. On left of Neville was Dinah, Jennifer's cousin. Then Steven Lou from New Ireland Province, High School educated at Rabaul. Grace was from Trobriand Islands, Milne Bay Province and Alotau, her home town. I, sitting next to her, found that her work was filling shipping containers with aged hospital equipment and forwarding them on to New Guinea. Dinah Ainui was from Gazelle Peninsula of East Britain province Rabaul home town. Jennifer is Dinah's cousin. Our Steven, Jenny and Dinah all come from East New Britain and Raubal and "Tolai" is their tribal family. **On top of all this it was Jennifer's birthday.**

Page 8 shows Neville, with teacher training, telling us the effect of plates and volcano activity, 2000 year ago, on the British Archipelago and Rabaul, then the more recent activity, destroying 80% of town and airstrip, 1994. Also of the Australian observatory, prior to WW2. and benefit of trial evacuations. He gave the history on German, British and Australian occupations, effect of WW1 and Japanese invasion WW2 leading to PNG being an independent Commonwealth country with a Governor General. He spoke of his 20 years service with Methodist Church and later the Uniting Church. Due to leave he was detailed to reconstruct records of Rabaul which were destroyed by Volcanic Ash. This was done by interviews with older people and examination of tunnels constructed under Rabaul by the Japanese. This led to writing "Mangroves, Cocoanuts, and Frangipani". Copy presented to club. Last photo shows Neville presented with our appreciation certificate.

Internationally there are 1,200,000 Rotarians serving in 34,145 clubs through 530 districts in 210 countries.
